### When

- ◆ **March 4, 2019 – February 28, 2020**
- ◆ Full-time Study: 32.5 hours per week - Monday thru Friday, 9:00AM-3:30 PM
- ◆ Some nights and weekends required
- ◆ Flexible schedule required for work placement

### Eligibility

- ◆ Indigenous Peoples in British Columbia who have a **strong** desire to enter the culinary, hospitality, tourism workforce.
- ◆ Grade 12 preferred, however all applicants will be considered.



### Selection Process

- ◆ Attendance at an information session if living on Southern Vancouver Island
- ◆ Completion of an application form
- ◆ Interview

### Program

Class size limited to 12 students.

Indigenous peoples from all communities are welcome to apply. Program sponsorship includes tuition, instructional costs, computer, program supplies and clothing.
